Programming changes



TTIQ is a talk and support group for trans, non-binary, and gender diverse adults ages 18 and older. In addition to the second Monday of the month, TTIQ has a *NEW* second monthly meeting on the fourth Friday, 7–9pm. Meeting dates in April are:

- Monday, April 8, 7–9pm
- Friday, April 26, 7–9pm

Trans Youth Group & Parents' and Caregivers' Support Group (TYG & PCSG) are two adjacent talk and support groups; one for trans, non-binary, and gender diverse youth ages 12–24, and the other for parents and caregivers who have trans, non-binary, and gender diverse children.

In March, these programs were running biweekly on Tuesday. Since March, the programming schedule has been reverted to its original third Monday of the month. In addition, it now also runs on the first Tuesday of the month, 7–9pm. Meeting dates in April are:

- Tuesday, April 2, 7–9pm
- Monday, April 15, 7–9pm

TTIQmunity is a new program and concept: An ALL AGES casual social gathering for trans, non-binary, and gender diverse people. It will take place on the first Wednesday of the month, 7–9pm, and launches on May 1st!

Drop In Single Session Counselling is a FREE drop-in psychological counselling service provided through partnership between The Family Centre of Northern Alberta, Boys and Girls Clubs Big Brothers Big Sisters of Edmonton and Area, Canadian Mental Health Association Edmonton Region, Edmonton John Howard Society, Seniors Association of Greater Edmonton (SAGE) and the Pride Centre of Edmonton.
